PROBLEM STATEMENT

Poverty

- Nearly 42% of the population lives below the poverty line;
- Poorly resourced schools;
- Limited facilities in rural areas;
- Lack of functioning toilets and drinking water;
- Not enough educational institutes.

Educational Challenges

- Late school enrollments;
- High school dropout (especially in early years);
- 1 in 5 school-aged children doesn't attend school;
- 37% of rural youths are illiterate;
- Not enough trained teachers;
- No proper teaching methods;
- Language boundaries due to many spoken languages or dialects.

Aptitude / Attitude

- Cannot take control of life;
- Trapped in social problems;
- Parents can't educate their children well;
- Can't cope with studies due to low concentration and/or IQ levels.



Project Teams


Being a district manager or assistant to it. Students learn how to galvanize teams, plan and organize events, intermediate project management, problem-solving, leadership.






